The Global Launch ASU-USA Pathways program is designed for university-bound international students who want to begin their undergraduate degree program right away, but need to first improve their English language proficiency scores for ASU admission. ASU-USA Pathways combines academic coursework with face-to-face English language and university preparation so you can earn university credits right away and strengthen your language and academic skills for full degree study at ASU.

Why choose ASU-USA Pathways?

Earn your ASU degree on time

You will begin your first-year, degree-seeking coursework on day one, which will keep you on track to complete your degree in 4 years. When you successfully complete* the ASU-USA Pathways program, you will transition into your sophomore** (second year) at ASU.
