Non-credit course descriptions:

Academic Foundations 1, 2, 3 (3 hrs) - This class develops the linguistic and cultural fluency of Pathways students in an American university academic setting.

Academic Skills 1, 2 & 3 (3 hrs)- This class supports Pathways students' by refining English language skills particularly in reading and writing.

Applied Academic English 1 & 2 (3 hrs) -This class supports for-credit university courses and prepares students as they transition into university.
